EMPLOYEE VOLUNTEERING

Days to Give Back: Employees are encouraged to spend two workdays each year volunteering: one day for a Westfield select activity and one day for a personal choice activity.

Volunteer Grant Program: Employees may also obtain donations for a qualifying nonprofit after contributing 15+ volunteer hours annually on personal time.


Launched in **2015**, Legacy of Caring has donated
